

HSCI 1000 Equivalency

OVERVIEW

Health Science 1000 is a prerequisite for the Bachelor of Science in Health Science program. At Stanislaus State, HSCI 1000 or NURS 1000 fulfills this pre-requisite. Currently, there is no single course equivalent at the community college. This course includes student success applications, Medical Terminology, and health careers. However, the following course combination would be considered equivalent:

MERCED COLLEGE

Students complete one course from each section (1,2, and 3):

1. Medical Terminology
2. GUID 30
3. GUID 48 or HSMV 22

MODESTO JUNIOR COLLEGE

Students complete one course from each section (1,2, and 3):

1. Medical Terminology
2. STSK 78
3. GUID 111 or NURS 115

COLUMBIA COLLEGE

Students complete one course from each section (1,2, and 3):

1. Medical Terminology (OFTEC 50 or HLTH 50)
2. GUID 18
3. GUID 1 or GUID 50

SAN JOAQUIN DELTA COLLEGE

Students complete one course from each section (1,2, and 3 or 1 and 4):

1. Medical Terminology + HS 39 or 95
2. GUID or COUN 31
3. FCS 2 or COUN 8
4. Skip step 2 and 3, and complete HS 39 or HS 95

CABRILLO COLLEGE

Students complete one course from each section (1,2, and 3):

1. Medical Terminology
2. CG 54
3. ALH 110

CONSUMNES RIVER COLLEGE

Students complete one course from each section (1 and 2):

1. Medical Terminology
2. HCD 310

LOS MEDANOS COLLEGE

Students complete one course from each section (1,2, and 3):

1. Medical Terminology (EMS 013 or VONURS 008)*
2. EMS 007 or COUNS 36
3. COUNS 34

AMERICAN RIVER COLLEGE

Students complete one course from each section (1 and 2):

1. AH 112
2. Medical Terminology (AH 311 or AH 110)

LOS POSITAS COLLEGE

Students complete one course from each section (1,2, and 3):

1. Medical Terminology
2. PCN 10
3. PCN 15

SOUTHWESTERN COLLEGE

Students complete one course from each section (1,2, and 3):

1. Medical Terminology (MEDOP 230)
2. PD 100a
3. PD 100 or PD 110

If the applicant does not meet the HSCI 1000 equivalent, at a minimum, the Medical Terminology course is required before beginning the program. The Medical Terminology course may be in-progress when applying to the program but must be successfully completed prior to the start of the program. The other components of the Health Science equivalency must be met prior to the start of the second semester of the program.
