Notes

- All prerequisites must be completed prior to beginning upper-division Health Science courses (junior year).
- All program courses must be completed successfully for admission to HSCI 4948. Facility immunization, drug screening, and background check requirements must also be met prior to internship placement.

- A total of 120 units is needed to graduate from the University. Fifty units must be completed at a 4-year university. Make sure all courses taken at the community college are CSU transferable.
