

Sequential Enrollment Pathway

In partnership with *Modesto Junior College*, *Merced College*, and *San Joaquin Delta College*, we are offering a Sequential Enrollment Pathway (SEP) that allows nursing students to complete fifteen Bachelor of Science in Nursing units, at Stan State, while completing their Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN). Upon completion of the fifteen units*, students are eligible to apply to our Online RN-BSN Accelerated Program. Sequential Enrollment Pathway courses are completed over two consecutive summer terms.

Eligibility requirements:

- Currently enrolled in one of our partner institutions,
- Must be enrolled in 1st, 2nd, or 3rd ADN semester at time of application,
- Minimum overall GPA of 2.0 required, and
- Full GE transfer certification (including chemistry and statistics).

Application Period: March 3 - May 2
